

# sgapiNumberFormat(%%value, %%decimals, %%dec\_point, %%thousands\_sep)

This is equivalent to the [number\\_format](#) function in PHP. This function can be used to format number entries in your survey.

## Parameters

- **%%value** - The number you are formatting.
- **%%decimals** - The number of decimals (default is 0).
- **%%dec\_point** - The character to use in place of a dot for the decimal mark (default is '.').
- **%%thousands\_sep** - the character to use in place of comma for thousands (default is ',')

## Example

The below script will format the number entered in question ID 2 to European number format e.g., 19.875,70

```
%%value = sgapiGetValue(2);
%%decimals = 2;
%%dec_point = ',';
%%thousands_sep = '.';

%%output .=
sgapiNumberFormat(%%value,%%decimals,%%dec_point,%%thousands_sep);
```
